

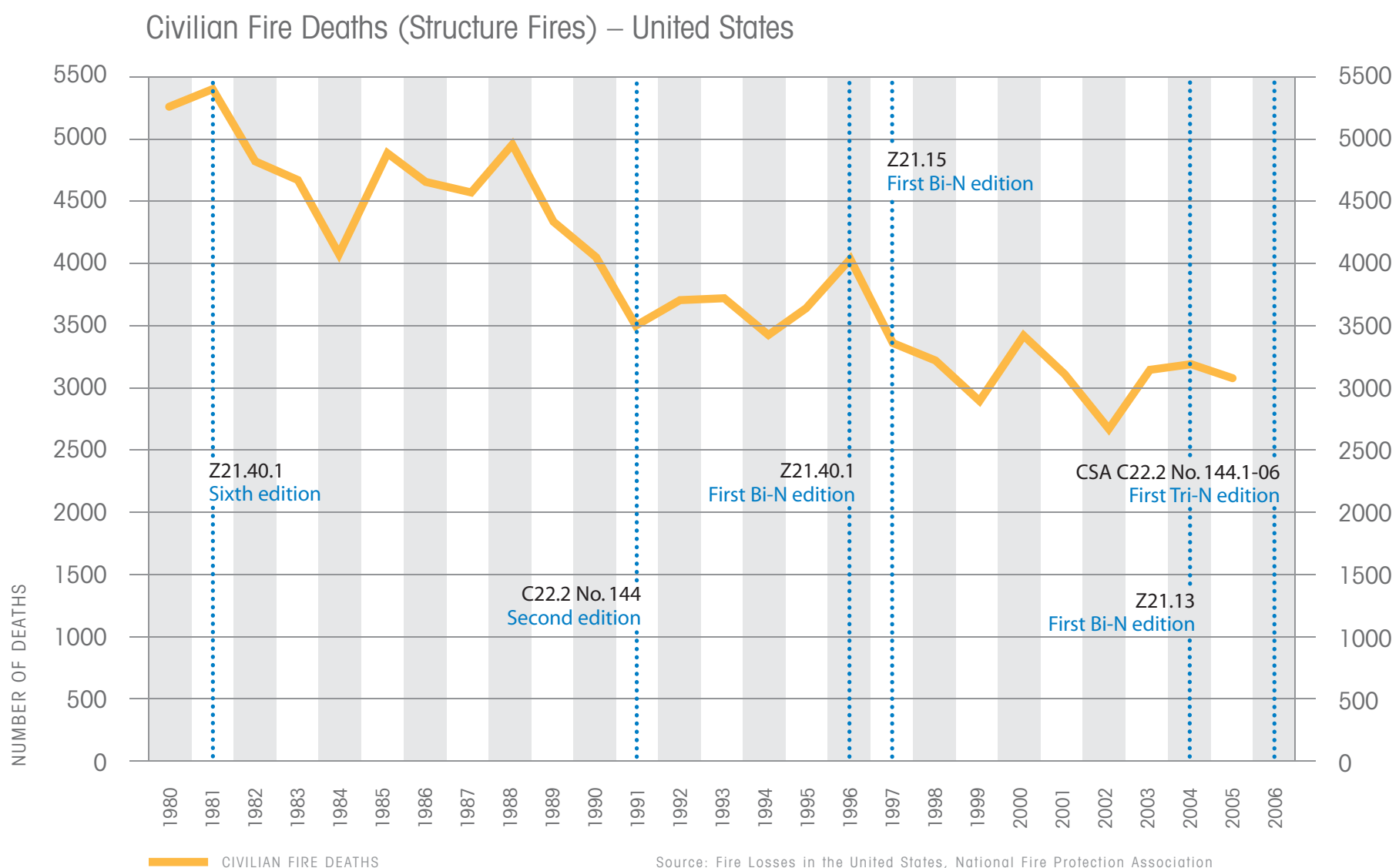
CSA standards and product certification help reduce civilian fire deaths.

Reducing civilian fire-related deaths

In the United States, civilian fire-related deaths have decreased from 5,200 in 1980 to 3,030 in 2005, with steady improvements.
