

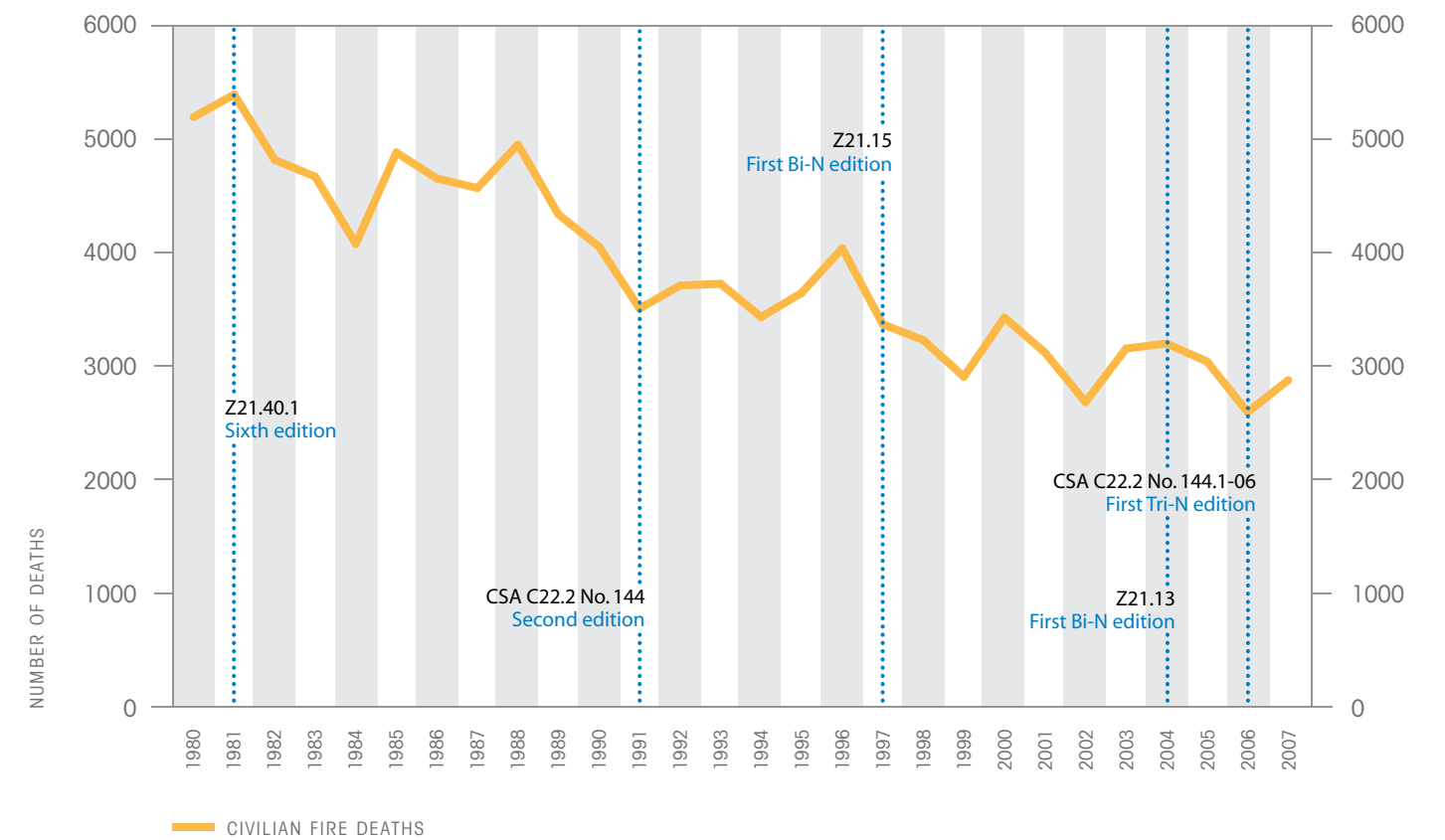
CSA Standards and Product Certification Help Reduce Civilian Fire Deaths



In the United States, civilian fire-related deaths have decreased from 5,200 in 1980 to 2,865 in 2007, with steady improvements.
