Background and Rationale

This is the third edition of CAN/CSA-E60335-2-82, Household and similar electrical appliances — Safety — Part 2-82: Particular requirements for amusement machines and personal service machines, which is an adoption, with Canadian deviations, of the identically titled IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) Standard 60335-2-82 (edition 2:2002 consolidated with Amendment 1:2008). It supersedes the previous edition published in 2006 as CAN/CSA-E60335-2-82 (adopted IEC 60335-2-82:2005).

This Standard is intended to be used in conjunction with CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 60335-1-11, Safety of Household and Similar Appliances — Part 1: General Requirements (adopted IEC 60335-1:2001+A1:2004+A2:2006, with Canadian deviations).
