Please note that all new applications and updates to currently CSA Certified product(s) will be evaluated to

the revised requirements, detailed in the "Major Revisions" section below.

Major Revisions:

- Clause 3.0 was revised adding a definition for "continuous load"; and Clause 4.1.4 was revised permitting a marked input rating greater than 1500W for non-continuous loaded products; or products marked with a duty cycle. These revisions were previously outlined in Technical Information Letter (TIL) No. C-37, which now has been included in its entirety. This TIL has now been cancelled.
- Flammability requirements based on CSA Standard C22.2 No. 0.6, Flammability Testing of Polymeric Materials, have now been superseded by CSA Standard C22.2 No. 0.17-00, Evaluation of Properties of Polymeric Materials. The latter CSA Standard is based on industry accepted American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) Standards for flammability ratings.
- Editorial changes related to the clarification of requirements.
