1, 2021. If testing is needed, we will inform you of the samples required.

ATTACHMENT 1

Major Revisions

The following describes the technical changes between CAN/CSA-E60335-2-28-01 and CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 60335-2-28:16. Editorial changes to the standard are not included.

Edition of the Part 1

This edition of CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 60335-2-28:16 is used in conjunction with CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 60335-1-11. The previous edition, CAN/CSA-E60335-2-28-01, was used in conjunction with CAN/CSA-E335-1/3E-94.

Technical Changes in this Part 2

ATTACHMENT 2

Background and Rationale

This is the third edition of CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 60335-2-28, Household and similar electrical appliances — Safety — Part 2-28: Particular requirements for sewing machines, which is an adoption, with Canadian deviations, of the identically titled IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) Standard 60335-2-28 (edition 4:2002 consolidated with Amendment 1:2008). It supersedes the previous edition published in 2001 as CAN/CSA-E60335-2-28 (adopted IEC 335-2-28:1994), and it replaces the requirements for sewing machines found in CSA C22.2 No. 68-09, Motor-operated appliances (household and commercial). CSA C22.2 No. 68 continues to apply to other motor-operated appliances. This Standard is one in a series of Standards issued by CSA Group under Part II of the Canadian Electrical Code.
