## Major Revisions

The following describes the technical changes between CAN/CSA-E60335-59-06 and CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 60335-2-59:16. Editorial changes to the standard are not included.

### **Edition of the Part 1**

This edition of CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 60335-2-59:16 is used in conjunction with CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 60335-1-11. The previous edition, CAN/CSA-E60335-2-59-06, was used in conjunction with CAN/CSA-E60335-1/4E:03.

### **Technical changes in this Part 2**

# **ATTACHMENT 2**

## Background and Rationale

This is the third edition of CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 60335-2-59, Household and similar electrical appliances — Safety — Part 2-59: Particular requirements for insect killers, which is an adoption, with Canadian deviations, of the identically titled IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) Standard 60335-2-59 (edition 3:2002 consolidated with Amendment 1:2006 and Amendment 2:2009). It supersedes the previous edition, published in 2006 as CAN/CSA-E60335-2-59 (adopted IEC 60335-2-59:2002), and it replaces CAN/CSA-C22.2 No. 189-M89, High-voltage insect killers. This Standard is one in a series of Standards issued by CSA Group under Part II of the Canadian Electrical Code.
