Background and Rationale

This is the fourth edition of CAN/CSA-E60335-2-6, Household and similar electrical appliances — Safety — Part 2-6: Particular requirements for stationary cooking ranges, hobs, ovens and similar appliances, which is an adoption, with Canadian deviations, of the identically titled IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) Standard 60335-2-6 (sixth edition, 2014-02). It supersedes the previous edition published in 2013 as CAN/CSA-E60335-2-6 (adopted IEC 60335-2-6:2002+A1:2004+A2:2008).
