Kim Greenwood has been an active member and leader on CSA committees for almost 20 years, primarily in the area of boilers and pressure vessels. As Chair of the Technical Committee on Boiler and Pressure Vessels (B51) and several of its subcommittees, she led the introduction of substantive changes to the code. These changes covered a wide range of subjects, including the creation of an entirely new section on safety pressure relief valve requirements, quality program requirements, technical requirements for piping, and administrative requirements for Canadian Registration Numbers (CRNs). Kim also participates on committees developing CSA B52, *Mechanical Refrigeration Code*, and numerous Compressed Gas Association (CGA) standards.

Kim's technical expertise has earned her respect among her colleagues; however, it is her communication style that is encouraging and laced with good humour that has effectively kept her committees consistently engaged and driven. Kim is noted to be a great leader and mentor,

motivating those around her to embrace committee work and CSA's culture of collaboration.
