### TECHNICAL SUMMARY:

#### Overview of changes:

This is the sixth edition of CSA/ANSI Z21.89 • CSA 1.18, Outdoor cooking specialty gas appliances.

#### Effect on Approvals:

It supersedes the previous editions published in 2017, 2013, 2007, 2004, and 2002.

1.6, 5.2, 5.3	Removed Mixed(Test Gas C) and Manufactured gas(Test Gas B) have been removed from the coverage of this standard.
4.1.7	Updated wording to include considerations and testing reference for surface temperatures of potential contact points.
4.1.18, 4.19.3 a) xviii) 8)	New requirement that gas components and automatic ignition systems shall be rated for a minimum ambient operating temperature of 0 degrees F or a lower temperature.
4.4 e)	New requirements covering the connection of a recreational vehicle outdoor cooking specialty gas applicant to a recreational vehicle’s low-pressure LP gas supply system.
4.7, 5.10	<b>Amendment 1</b> - Updated requirements to specify the use of a ANSI Z21.15/CSA 9.1 certified manual valve at all pressures now covered by the standard. ANSI Z21.15/CSA 9.1 now covers certification of valves up to 72 PSI so appliances that operate at higher pressure will need to have a valve certified for the correct pressure.
4.12, 5.8, 5.25	<b>Amendment 1</b> – Updated the method permit to accomplish burner ignition. The standard now does not specify a “paper book match” and now specify “by an external means”, this must be according to the manufacturers instructions. Examples of external means include, a multi-purpose, long neck butane lighter, or a match (fireplace/square/paper book), the appliance manufacturer must specify the means to be used.
4.19.3 a) iv)	New statement required in the instructions outlining Outdoor use
4.19.3 a) xix)	Additional requirement for a statement in the instructions that the appliance shall not be used under overhead combustible construction.
4.19.3 iv) and viii)	New instruction requirements for recreational vehicle gas outdoor appliances
4.20.5 h)	Update of rating plate to have the new standard edition and title “CSA/ANSI Z21.89:(year) • CSA 1.18:(year) Outdoor cooking specialty gas appliance”
4.20.5 l)	New requirement to list the minimum ambient operating temperature in °F and °C on the rating plate.
5.1.1	Clarification that testing to this standard shall be done at altitudes below 2000 ft(600 m)
5.1.3	Clarification that when tested the mounting methods and adjustable legs shall be placed in the most unfavourable position
5.8.2 g)	Change of temperature requirements for alkaline batteries from 160 °F to 130 °F to align with allowable temperatures specified by manufacturers
5.25	Added allowance for the use of a flame sensing device to shut down gas supply if wind extinguishes flame.
Annex D	New annex that covers the use of smart enabled features with outdoor cooking specialty gas appliances.
Annex E	New annex that details the method of measuring and calculating input rate.
