ATTACHMENT 1

Major Revisions

- Clause 6.1 Maximum distance (headform to face protector)
Correct the error of Clause 6.1. “The point k on the facially featured headform” was changed to “the point g on the facially featured headform”.
- Clause 7.4.2 Positioning (all Types)
Clause 7.4.2 was revised to clarify that a helmet with a full-face protector or a helmet with a goalkeeper mask shall be positioned on the largest headform for its size range according to the manufacturer’s instructions so that the chin portion of the protector rests on the load-bearing area of the headform and the helmet is positioned as close to the HPI as possible.
- Clause 9.2 Information
Clause 9.2 added a statement to clarify that if permanent marking of Clause 9.2 a), c), f) and g) is not possible in view of the characteristics of the product, the marking shall be affixed to the packaging.
