CAN/CSA-Z241.5, Electrical requirements for park model trailers.

These Standards were prepared by the Technical Committee on Park Models, under the jurisdiction of the Strategic Steering Committee on Construction and Civil Infrastructure, and have been formally approved by the Technical Committee.

All previously certified park model trailer units are required to be re-evaluated to the new requirements

## Major Revisions

<b>Clause(s)</b>	<b>Changes</b>
<b>CAN/CSA-Z241.0-18 Definitions and general safety requirements</b>	
3	Introducing a new definition for loft and revising the definition of Park Model Trailer to prohibit lofts.
4.1.1	New clause allowing park model trailer units to be manufactured without kitchens or bathrooms as they are considered optional features. The clause also prohibits lofts.
4.1.2.2	New clause allowing Park model trailer units to be manufactured with additions to be attached on site.
4.1.5	New clause prohibiting oil-fired appliances and equipment in park model trailers
4.5	New clause requiring every park model trailer to have a carbon monoxide detector that is approved for use in recreational vehicles and park model trailers and complies with CSA 6.19 or ANSI/UL 2034. The detector shall be installed in accordance with its manufacturer's instructions.

5.1.1.2	New clause allowing Park model trailer units to be manufactured with additions to be attached on site
<b>CAN/CSA-Z241.3-18 Plumbing System Requirements</b>	
4.3.5	Updating the clause to allow Cellular Core pipe, manufactured in compliance with ASTM F628-2012 (E 2016) standard, to be used in a drainage and/or venting system.
<b>CAN/CSA-Z241.5-18 Electrical Requirements</b>	
5.6.1	Updating the clause To allow appliance branch circuits to be protected by overcurrent devices rated or set at not more than 20 A when the Park Model Trailer has a 50 A attachment plug
