Introduction:

This announces the publication of the bi-national CSA Group and UL Standard for Positioning Devices. It is the second edition of CSA C22.2 No. 18.5, and the fifth edition of UL 1565. This edition of CSA-C22.2 No. 18.5 supersedes the previous edition published in 2002.

Major Revisions:

This new edition of the standard removes cable ties and cable tie accessories, nonmetallic mechanical protective tubing (NMPT), and hardware for the support of conduit, tubing and cable from the scope, as outlined in Attachment 1. Any of these products as well as any other positioning devices that have been certified to the previous edition of this standard will not be required to re-apply to maintain certification.

Refer to Attachment 1 for details of all revisions to CSA C22.2 No 18.5/ UL1565 from the previous edition of the standard.

Major Revisions between C22.2 No. 18.5-13 and C22.2 No. 18.5-02

Clause	Differences from C22.2 No. 18.5-02 to 18.5-13
1.2 (new)	Added that cable ties and cable tie accessories, coated electrical sleeving, extruded insulating tubing, metallic or non-metallic raceways, or woven flexible nonmetallic tubing are not within the scope of this standard. Note 1 refers to the standard CAN/CSA C22.2 62275 or UL 62275 for cable ties. Note 2 refers to standard CSA C22.2 No. 227.3 or UL 1696 for nonmetallic mechanical protective tubing (NMPT)
1.4 (new)	Added that this standard does not apply to hardware for support of conduit, tubing and cable. The Note refers to standard CSA C22.2 No. 18.4 or UL 2239.
